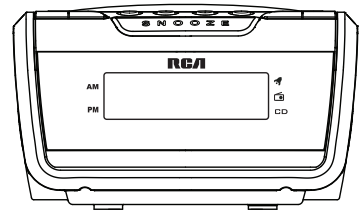

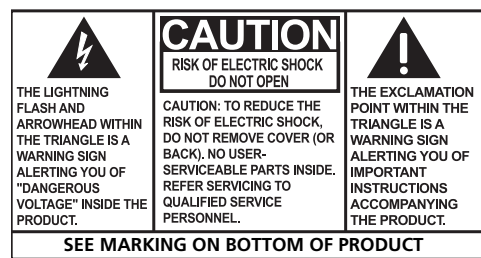

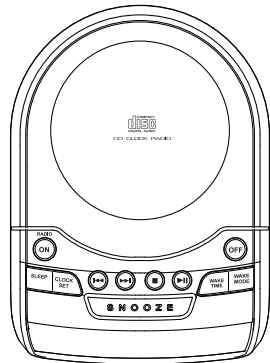

General controls

Top view



RADIO ON – turns on the radio; selects the radio from other modes

OFF – turns off the unit; turns off the wake function and sleep mode

⏮ / ⏭ – sets clock or wake time; skips to previous or next CD track during CD playback

■ – stops CD playback

⏮ – turns on the unit from CD mode; pauses or resumes CD playback

SLEEP – activates the Sleep function

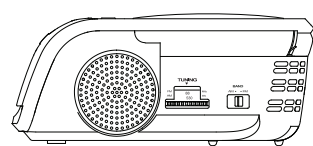
CLOCK SET – activates clock time setting mode

WAKE TIME – activates wake time setting mode; checks current wake time

WAKE MODE – activates wake function and changes wake mode

SNOOZE – turns off the wake function temporarily; cancels the sleep function

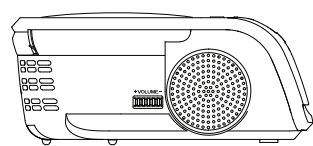
Right view

Left view

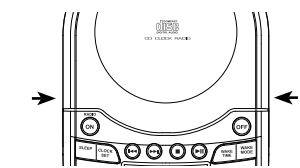


+ VOLUME – adjusts volume

CD player

Listening to CD

1. Lift open the CD compartment door.



- If disc is paused for more than 5 minutes, the CD player will resume to stop mode automatically.
- If disc is stopped in the CD mode for more than 30 minutes without further operations, the unit will turn off automatically.

2. Insert a disc and close the door.
3. Press **⏮** to select CD mode and start CD playback.
- Press **⏮** to pause playback and press again to resume.
4. Adjust volume to your desired level.
5. Press **⏮** or **⏭** to skip backward or forward a track. Press and hold to search through a track.
6. Press **■** to stop playback.
7. Press **RADIO ON** to listen to the radio or **OFF** to turn off the unit.

Wake function

Setting wake time

1. Press **WAKE TIME** once. The current wake time flashes on the display.



2. Press **⏮** or **⏭** to set the wake time. The time decrements or increments will follow by a faster rate when you press and hold the buttons. AM or PM indicator also lights beside the time on the display.

3. When finished, wait for about 5 seconds or press **WAKE TIME** to exit wake time setting mode.

- The Wake to Alarm mode (read below) will be automatically activated whenever the wake time has been set.

Selecting wake source

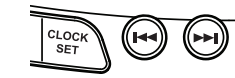
1. If your desired wake source is radio or CD:
 - Wake to Radio – select an AM or FM station (refer to "Radio").
 - Wake to CD – insert a CD in the CD compartment.
2. Set a wake time (refer to "Setting wake time").
3. Press **WAKE MODE** repeatedly to select a wake source. The indicator lights against the wake source icons on the right of the display to indicate the currently selected wake source:
 - ☀ – wake by alarm
 - 📻 – wake by radio
 - CD – wake by CD

- Once the wake source is selected, the wake function will be activated at the set wake time.

Clock

Setting clock

1. Press **CLOCK SET** once. The current clock time flashes on the display.



2. Press **⏮** or **⏭** to set the clock time. The time decrements or increments will follow by a faster rate when you press and hold the buttons. AM or PM indicator also lights beside the time on the display.



3. When finished, wait for about 5 seconds or press **CLOCK SET** to exit clock setting mode.

Radio

Switching on

Press **RADIO ON** to turn on the radio.

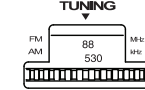
Switching band

Slide the **BAND/AM-FM** switch on the right of the unit to select AM or FM band.



Tuning radio

Rotate the **TUNING** dial on the right of the unit to select radio frequency.



Antennas

AM Antenna – A built-in ferrite rod antenna eliminates the need for an outside antenna for AM reception. Rotating the unit slightly may improve reception of distant AM stations.

FM Antenna – The power cord acts as your FM antenna. The power cord picks up moderate to strong stations and eliminates the need for an external antenna in most strong signal areas. Be sure the power cord is stretched out to its full length. Do not coil or bunch the cord together. Changing position of the power cord may improve reception.

Built-in AFC – The Built In Automatic Frequency Control (AFC) works only on FM. It helps reducing drift on FM reception and keeping the radio locked in on the FM station to which it is tuned.

When tuning in FM stations, you may notice that the station you are tuning can be well-tuned on two or three nearby points on the dial. Always tune carefully at the loudest and clearest point.

Limited warranty

Limited Warranty (US)

What your warranty covers:

- Defects in materials or workmanship.

For how long after your purchase:

- One year from date of purchase.

- The warranty period for rental units begins with the first rental or 45 days from date of shipment to the rental firm, whichever comes first.

What we will do:

- Provide you with a new, or at our option, a refurbished unit. The exchange unit is under warranty for the remainder of the original product's warranty period.
- Proof of purchase in the form of a bill of sale or receipted invoice which is evidence that the product is within the warranty period must be presented to obtain warranty service. For rental firms, proof of first rental is also required.

How to make a warranty claim:

- Properly pack your unit. Include any cables, etc., which were originally provided with the product. We recommend using the original carton and packing materials.
- Include evidence of purchase date such as the bill of sale. Also print your name and address and a description of the defect. Send via standard UPS or its equivalent to:
- Insure your shipment for loss or damage. Thomson accepts no liability in case of damage or loss en route to Thomson.
- Pay any charges billed to you by the Exchange Center for service not covered by the warranty.
- A new or refurbished unit will be shipped to you freight prepaid.

What your warranty does not cover:

- Customer instruction. (Your Owner's Manual provides information regarding operating Instructions and user controls. For additional information, ask your dealer.)
- Installation and set-up service adjustments.
- Batteries.
- Damage from misuse or neglect.
- Products which have been modified or incorporated into other products.
